To Headquarters from Thomasville – Take Hwy 19 North. Go 16 miles north of Thomasville to Palmer Rd. Headquarters is at the corner of Hwy 19 and Palmer Rd on the left.

From Headquarters to the Dunaway Farm (Started/Seasoned) – Turn North (left) on Hwy 19. Go 3 miles to Register Road (dirt road). Turn right on Register Road. Take the first right (about 100 yards) onto Hurst Tate Road. Go ½ mile to 1088 Hurst Tate Road and turn left.
